## WHERE WERE YOUNG PEOPLE IN NSW STAYING?

### WHAT THE DATA SHOWS US

For in infographic, youth refers to people aged 12-24.

In total, **9,042 between the ages of 12-24 in NSW were classified as homeless on Census night 2016** (an increase from 6,630 in 2011).

**Young people aged between 12-24 account for 33% of the entire population of people in NSW, classified as homeless on Census night 2016.**
