Asset Management	Management of the asset following construction completion	
Service Provision	Delivery of homelessness and DFV services.	 Must include: DCJ funded SHS with DFV specialisation or NGO that can demonstrate its capability of: Delivering DFV support services Meeting the SHS program guidelines including Accreditation

Core and Cluster Sector Capacity and Capability Building Program

Homelessness NSW (HNSW), Domestic Violence NSW (DVNSW) and the Aboriginal Community Housing Industry Association (ACHIA) are working together to deliver a program of <u>sector engagement</u>, <u>capacity and capability building</u>, and <u>grants of up to \$20,000</u> to support the success of the Core and Cluster procurement.

The program will prioritise Aboriginal community-controlled organisations, regional based projects, and smaller organisations with less than \$5 million in revenue each year.
